

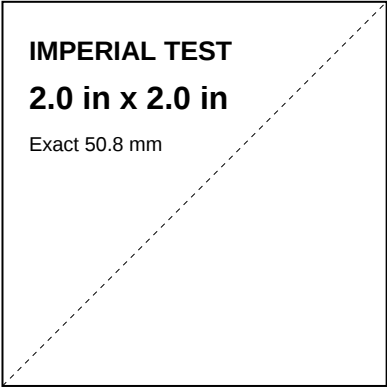
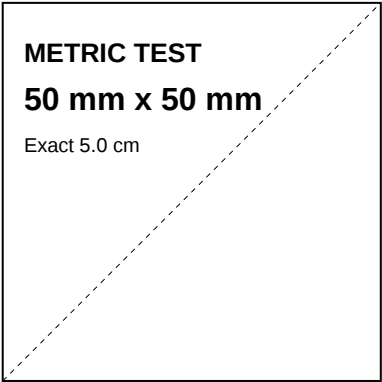
Mandarin Collar Tunic

A graceful everyday tunic featuring a split stand-up mandarin collar, 3/4 sleeves, and side slits

PRINTER CALIBRATION & SCALE VERIFICATION

Measure both test squares with a rigid ruler before cutting fabric. Print at 100% scale without shrinking.



- Scale Rules:
1. Open in Acrobat Reader
 2. Select Actual Size 100%
 3. Do NOT Fit to Page
 4. Verify dimensions above

SIZE SELECTION & EASE RECOMMENDATIONS

Tunic length extends to mid-thigh. Check both bust and hip measurements to ensure sufficient ease over hips.

Comfortable ease of +14 cm +5.5" at bust and +16 cm +6.3" over hips with side slit freedom.

RECOMMENDED FABRICS & STRETCH PROPERTIES

Recommended Substrates: Pure European Linen 140 160 gsm for organic luxury, Cotton ikat, khadi, or handwoven cottons for artisanal character, Tencel modal twill for liquid softness and drape, Crisp cotton poplin for clean architectural lines.

Stretch Requirement: None 0% stretch - stable woven.

NOTIONS & SEWING TOOLS CHECKLIST

- ☐ 2 buttons for sleeve tabs 12 mm
- ☐ Fusible interfacing 0.3 m for collar
- ☐ Matching thread
- ☐ Sharp fabric shears

PATTERN INVENTORY & CUTTING LAYOUT

STANDARD SEAM & HEM ALLOWANCES

Use the seam and hem allowances printed on each pattern piece. Verify every allowance label before cutting fabric.

PATTERN PIECE INVENTORY & CUTTING SCHEDULE

Piece Name	Cut Quantity	Material / Interfacing
Front Tunic with Split	Cut 1 on fold	Main Fabric
Back Tunic on Fold	Cut 1 on fold	Main Fabric
Mandarin Collar Stand	Cut 2 (1 interfaced)	Main Fabric
3/4 Sleeve	Cut 1 pair	Main Fabric
Sleeve Tabs	Cut 2	Main Fabric

FABRIC PREPARATION & CUTTING RULES

- Interface collar pieces.
- Mark split neckline depth precisely.

MULTI-PAGE TILE ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Check Sheet 1 calibration square before printing the remaining pattern sheets.
2. Trim right and bottom border lines along the dashed perimeter frame.
3. Match corner crosshairs, such as A1 to A2 and B1 to B2, without overlapping.
4. Tape sheets securely on both sides before cutting paper pieces.

STEP-BY-STEP SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1: Construct Split Neck Facing

Apply facing to front tunic split right sides together. Stitch around V-point, clip to apex, turn to inside, and press seam allowances.

Step 2: Shoulder Seams & Mandarin Collar

Align front tunic and Back Tunic on Fold right sides together at shoulder seams. Stitch shoulder seams and press seam allowances open. Assemble curved mandarin stand collar, stitch outer collar to neckline right sides together, and enclose raw edges.

Step 3: Sleeves and Roll Tabs

Sew button tabs. Insert sleeves flat into armholes right sides together. Stitch sleeve and side seams right sides together down to side slit marks, and press seam allowances.

Step 4: Finish Side Vents & Hem

Turn under and topstitch side vents. Sew double fold hem along bottom edge, and press seam allowances.

TROUBLESHOOTING & PRO SEWING TIPS

Issue: Mandarin collar stands unevenly

Fix: Clip seam allowance along neckline curve so collar relaxes against neck.
